Past tenses

- Narrative tenses: past, past continuous, past perfect, past perfect continuous
- used to, would,

Future

- will, future perfect, future continuous
- Other ways to express future – be about to, be due to, etc.
- Future in the past

Modals, the imperative, etc.

- Modal verbs e.g. may, can, must, have to, mustn't, don't have to (permission, obligation, prohibition, necessity)
- may, might, could, must, can't and expressions (Speculation and deduction)
- see, hear, taste, smell, feel (Verbs of the senses)
- get – different meanings

Conditionals, if, wish, etc.

- All conditionals (mixed conditionals, alternatives to if, inversion)
- Mixed conditionals: If I were you, I wouldn't have done it
- Wish, rather, if only, it's time (unreal uses of past tenses)
- unless, even if, provided, as long as, etc. (other expressions in conditionals)

Passive

- expressions and passive of reporting verbs (distancing)

-ing and the infinitive

- Verb + object + infinitive/gerund (verb patterns)
- Gerunds and infinitives (complex forms)

Articles, nouns, pronouns, and determiners

- Reflexive and reciprocal pronouns
- Generic pronouns – common-gender pronouns
- Compound nouns and possessive forms

Relative clauses, relative pronouns and adverbs

- Relative clauses – defining and non-defining

there and it

- There and it (preparatory subjects)

Auxiliary verbs

- have – auxiliary or main verb
- Ellipsis and substitution

Adjectives and adverbs

- Inversion with negative adverbials (adding emphasis)

Conjunctions and clauses

- Clauses of contrast, purpose, reason and result
- Discourse markers – linking words
- Participle clauses

Word order

- Cleft sentences (adding emphasis)
